

## Shamanic Initiation Program

### *Purpose:*

To connect with the Elements and the Spirits of Earth, an introduction. Introducing yourself to them, and them to you. A path in Shamanism is a life commitment. Transformation is always part of the process. This is not a fast process; it is important to not rush it.

### *Process:*

Done in different steps, I recommend taking a minimum of 3 to 6 months for the entire process. Everything will be synchronized at a date and time, and all meetings will be done by video. We will have a WhatsApp chat to keep up with progress, ask questions, etc. Depending on the flow, it may vary a little, but these will be the steps.

- **Onboarding:** 30 to 45 minutes Zoom meeting. We will get to know each other and talk about the process.
- **First initiation:** Visit the Lower World to experience it for the first time. Early realizations, or epiphanies may happen, among other situations that you experience without expectation.
  - First Video Meeting: 30 to 45 minutes. We will meet a few days later to share insights, work on integration, and any questions.
  - Recommended reintegration time: 1 month. We will have a WhatsApp chat to talk.
- **Second Initiation:** Visit the Lower World, meet Elemental and other beings (that you may have met on the first one), potentially your Power Animal, and more. This second trip is in a way showing your ongoing commitment to keep transforming this way.
  - Second Video Meeting: 30 to 45 minutes.
  - Recommended reintegration time: 1-2 months. We will have a WhatsApp chat to talk.
- **Third Initiation:** Visit the Upper World to show your complete and profound commitment, sealing your path with the Spirits to dedicate yourself to this beautiful path. Amazing things can happen here.
  - Third Video Meeting: 30 to 45 minutes.
  - From here, we will hold the WhatsApp chat for one more month.

### *Price:*

This will be a 90-to-180-day process (\$999)

There is also an option to pay for one initiation at a time: \$350 each. Total: \$1050 (3 initiations.)
